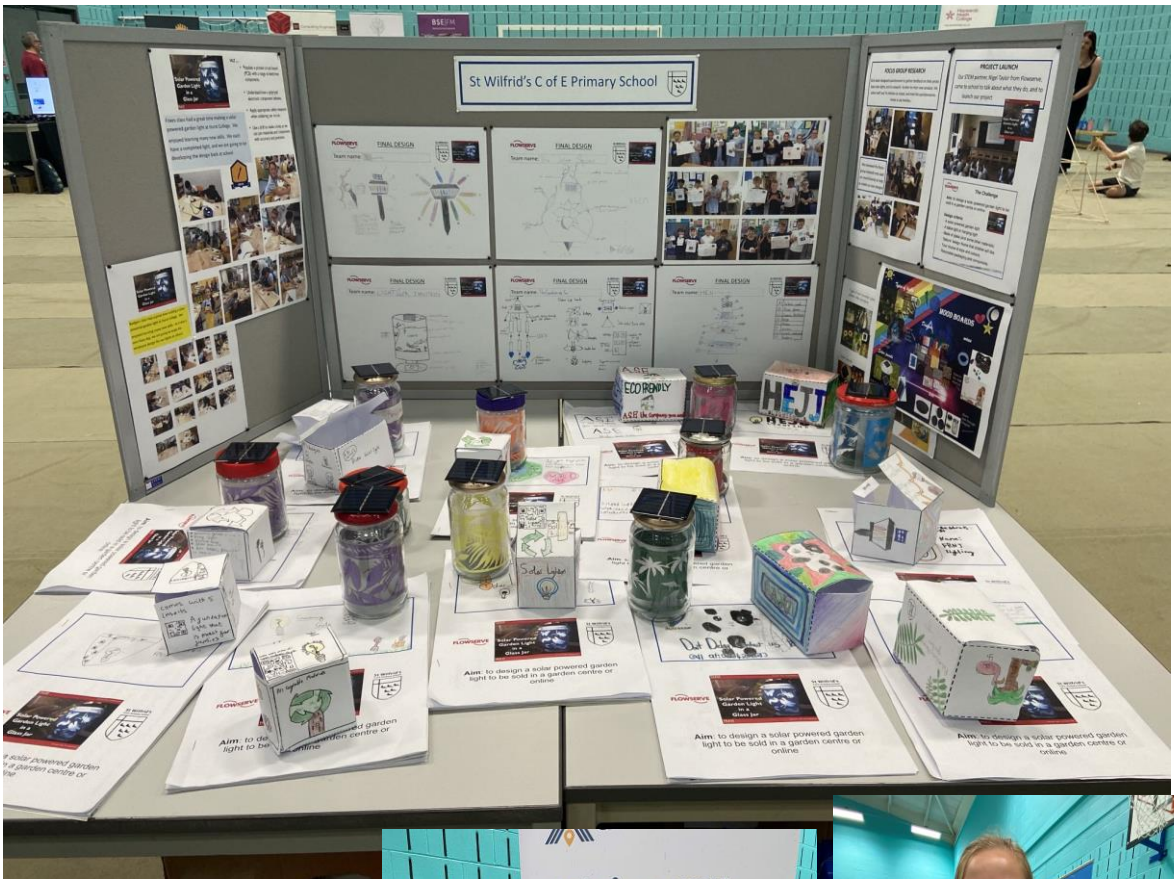
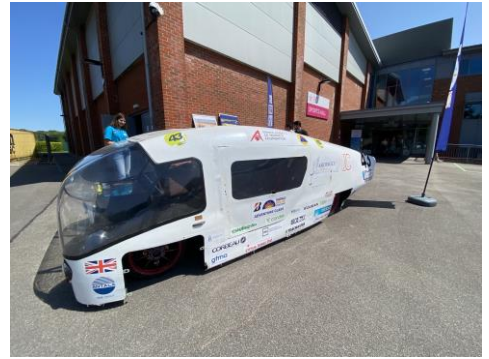


Our Project Learning this term...

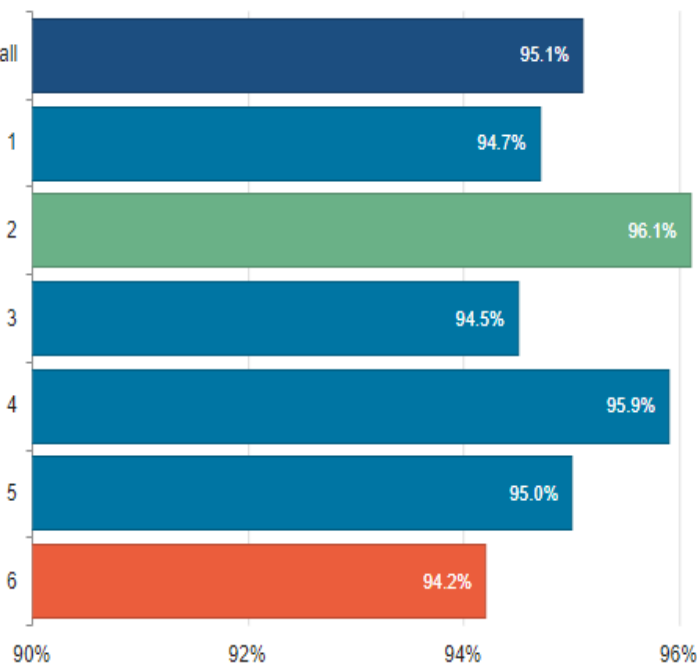
