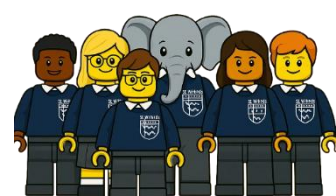


75 Years on Eastern Road

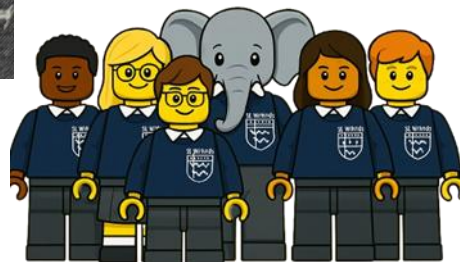
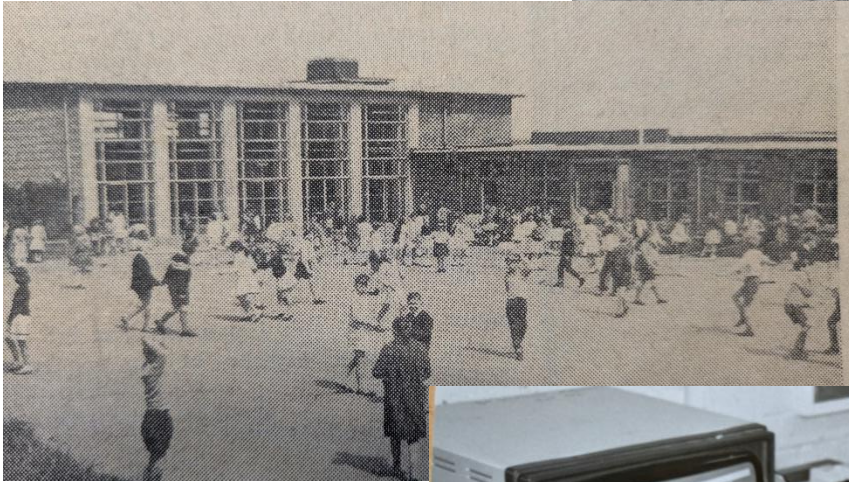
Later in the morning, the whole school gathered on the field creating a giant 75 (Thank you to Mr Bannister for taking the photo and creating a video of our 75).

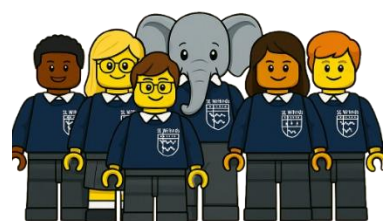
Stations of the Resurrection

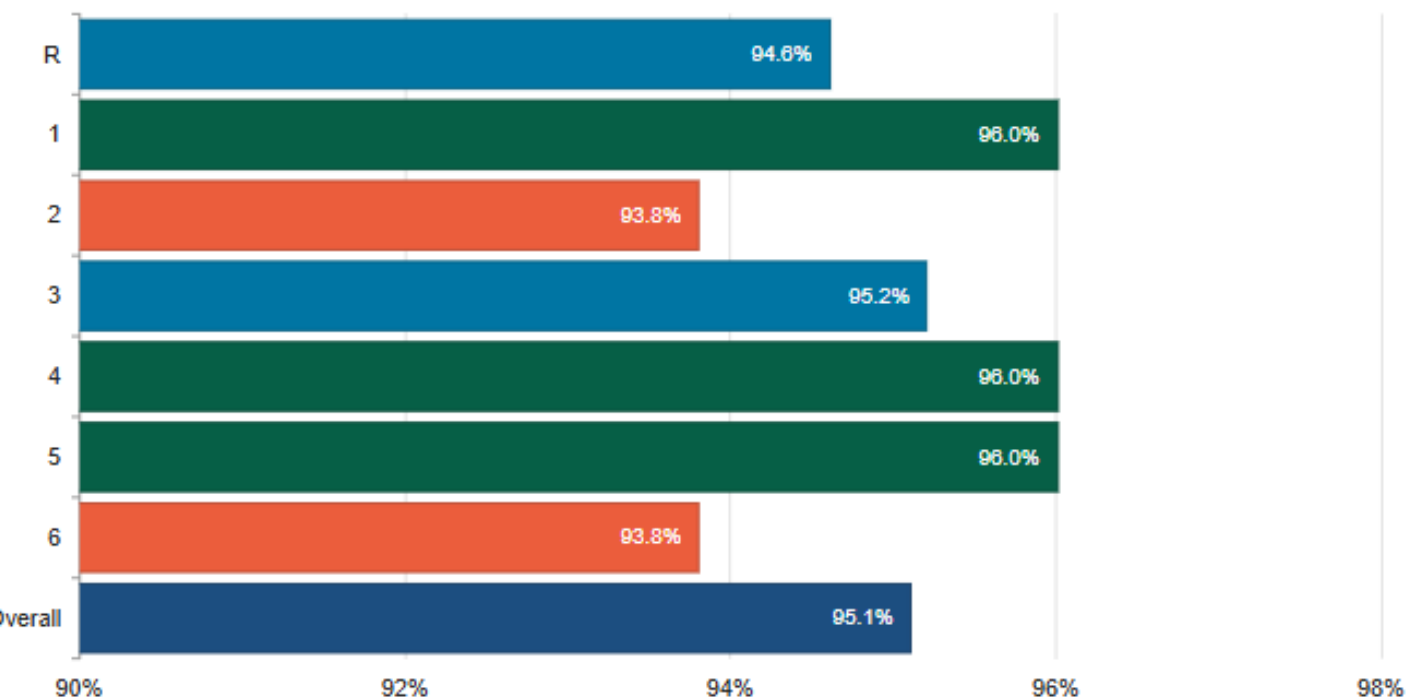




Attendance
